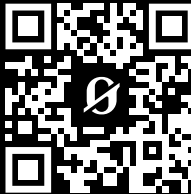

ESSENTIAL SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

GET THE PERFECT FIT

No helmet can guarantee total protection from all high and low-speed impacts, but a proper fit makes all the difference. Make sure your helmet sits snug with the retention system securely fastened under your chin. This keeps your helmet in place so you stay focused on the ride, not on adjusting your gear.

FASTEN UP

Put your helmet on and pull the chinstrap tight. Make sure it's only the chinstrap you're pulling, not the chinstrap covers, which may cause damage to the fabric. Tug to test it, and if your helmet still feels loose, it's time to size down.

ONE IMPACT & LET IT GO

All helmets are built to protect you from only ONE impact, seriously. After a hit, the helmet's liners become compacted, losing their impact-absorbing qualities. Even if it

looks fine on the outside, its protective power is gone. Never play with risks; replace it.

CLEAN IT RIGHT

Ditch the harsh stuff. Avoid hot or salted water, chemicals such as benzene, gasoline, glass cleaner, or other solvents. They may alter or weaken your helmet's protective qualities. Instead, wipe it down with a soft cloth dipped in a mild soap solution (5 drops of soap in warm water does the trick). Rinse off with a clean, damp cloth, and you're good to go.

KEEP IT ORIGINAL

Modifying your helmet may seem cool, but it risks compromising its protective structure. No drilling, no add-ons, and no removing parts, which may expose you to unexpected dangers. For the best safety and performance, stick with approved GRACSHAW helmet parts only.

HANDLE WITH CARE

Your helmet's tough, but it's not invincible. Never leave it hanging from the helmet holder or dangling from the mirror. Don't toss it around, sit on it, or subject it to heavy impacts. Keep it away from intense sunlight, extreme temperatures, and harsh chemicals; your helmet will thank you.

CHECK BEFORE YOU RIDE:

- **Cracks or impact damage** - If you spot cracks or serious damage, it's time to retire your helmet.
- **Shield and visor screws** - Give them a quick check and tighten if needed.
- **Component condition** - Replace worn-out plastic parts to keep your helmet solid and secure.

ENSURE GOOD VISOR VISIBILITY

Excessively scratched or stained visors reduce visibility. Clean your visor regularly with mild soapy water for optimal cleanliness and visibility. If it's beyond cleaning, replace it with a new one to stay safe on the road.

NO REPAINTING

Painting your helmet may seem like a fresh idea, but the chemicals in paint solutions such as thinner or other agents can damage or weaken its structure. Keep it original, keep it safe.

STAY ALERT ANYTIME, ANYWHERE

Your helmet protects you, but it can also limit your senses. Full-face or jet-type helmets may reduce awareness of sudden weather changes like rain or temperature drops, which can cause fogging and affect visibility. Stay alert and stay ready for whatever comes your way.

No helmet can protect the wearer against all foreseeable impacts. Nothing is a substitute for safe riding practices.
